CODEY SCHEDULES HIGHLANDS SENATE VOTE FOR THURSDAY

TRENTON - Senate President Richard J. Codey today praised the Senate Environment Committee for approving the Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act and said he would post it for a full vote in the Senate on Thursday, June 10th.

“Millions of gallons of clean drinking water will continue to flow every day because of the hard work of the Senate Environment Committee in forging a compromise on this landmark legislation (S-1).

“Senator (Bob) Smith (Chairman of the Senate Environment Committee) and Senator (Stephen) Sweeney (Vice Chairman) found the common ground to protect our water supply for future generations while also ensuring them a place to live at the same time,” Senator Codey said.

“I am confident the Senate will provide this measure with strong bipartisan support because clean water and rational development are good for everyone,” Senator Codey said.
